

WINTER REMINDER

Dear Parent/Guardian

With the current cold/flu and viral season we would like to remind you of our school attendance guidelines policy regarding when you should keep your child at home.

1. Fevers of 100F or more and 24 hours fever free - without fever reducing medication.
2. Skin rashes of unknown origin or any rash accompanied by fever.
3. Vomiting - Symptom free for 24 hours and able to tolerate a regular diet.
4. Diarrhea - Symptom free for 24 hours and able to tolerate a regular diet.
5. Severe abdominal cramps.
6. Strep throats that have not had a minimum of 24-hour antibiotic treatment at home prior to returning to school.
7. Conjunctivitis as determined by the school nurse.
8. Students who cannot manage secretions (nasal or oral) due to a cold will be seen by the nurse who will determine if the student needs to be dismissed.

Thank you for your cooperation with our efforts to reduce absenteeism and maintain a healthy school environment. Please contact your school nurse with any questions.
